



Club Membership Rules for Lucky Dog Training Club

To ensure a positive experience for all users, the following are the rules for use.

Hours of Use by Members

🐾 Lucky Dog is open for all club members from 7 a.m. until 10 p.m. except for those times or days that a special activity, class, event, or maintenance is planned.

🐾 For days or hours that the facility is unavailable, please observe any posted signs, as well as our class and events calendar (<https://luckydogsportsclub.mhsoftware.com>). (May also include the day before a special event).

How to Apply for Membership

To be considered for membership please return all forms found at <https://luckydogtrainingclub.com/site/fetch-a-membership/>. (Click Fetch A Membership.) The forms are submitted electronically. Find the membership application at <https://luckydogtrainingclub.com/site/membership-application/>

After receiving the application, your Pooch Pass access card will be provided to you. Your Pooch Pass allows access to the appropriate facility entryways, such as doors and gate. Please allow one week for processing. Your pass will automatically expire unless you renew your membership.

The minimum membership duration is one month and all memberships will end at the end of any calendar month regardless of when they began. We can prorate any additional days of your membership start date that fall before the actual full month.

Persons Permitted to Use the Facility

- 🐾 Only paying club members who have their up-to-date Pooch Pass access card on their person.
- 🐾 The Pooch Pass access card is non-transferable and will be confiscated and not returned if found with a non-member.
- 🐾 All members must have an up-to-date signed waiver on file.
- 🐾 All children under the age of 15 must be well behaved and accompanied and supervised by an adult.
- 🐾 You may bring two human guests to observe. They may not bring their own canine friends.
- 🐾 Your membership is either for use of the agility field, or indoor training room(s), or both. You can only use the type of facility for which you are signed up and paid for.

Safety First

- 🐾 All dogs must be properly inoculated, including current for the Bordetella vaccine.
- 🐾 Dogs must be healthy and parasite free. Do not bring dogs that are coughing or showing signs of illness.
- 🐾 That said, we are not responsible for your pet's health and safety and you fully understand and agree to bear all responsibility and costs should any health issue occur.
- 🐾 All dogs must be leashed until safely inside the training area and returned to a leash prior to exiting. Owners must always have one leash per dog.
- 🐾 Owners are encouraged to inquire about any dogs off leash that are already in the facility that are unfamiliar to them, prior to entering; this will help prevent altercations.
- 🐾 No dog aggression is allowed - you must keep your dog under control at all times. Owners must immediately leash and remove dogs from the facility at the first sign of aggressive, hostile, or combative behavior.
- 🐾 Children must ask permission before petting members' dogs. Children must be supervised at all times by a responsible adult.
- 🐾 Keep all gates and/or doors closed at all times to prevent escape.
- 🐾 No dogs should be left unattended or unsupervised.
- 🐾 For safety and positive training reasons pinch (prong), choke collars and shock collars are not allowed. A basic flat buckle collar, head collars and harnesses are recommended. A flat buckle collar should be used on the agility course.
- 🐾 Do not allow your dogs on the contact equipment (A-frame, teeter and dogwalk) unless you have taken agility classes and are familiar with their use. This is for the safety (physical and mental) of your dog.

General Rules

🐾 **You may NOT use the facility for teaching purposes or for financial gain. An exception are currently employed Lucky Dog instructors who have prior authorization.**

- 🐾 Do not open doors or gates for others - they need to use their own Pooch Pass access card.
- 🐾 Keep your card on you at all times to prevent getting locked out.
- 🐾 Place all trash and discarded food items in the provided trashcans
- 🐾 We are not responsible for personal items left: crates, x-pens, leashes, jackets, etc.
- 🐾 Owners must clean up after their dogs. Dispose of waste properly in the designated on-site containers. To clean up accidents inside, use the spray disinfectant provided.
- 🐾 Dogs that are not being worked need to be crated or penned, or held on leash.
- 🐾 Be courteous of time training in the facility when other members are present. If more than one person is present, please practice no more than 10 minutes per person at a time.
- 🐾 Smoking is strictly forbidden inside the facility and inside the fenced training field. Smoking outside of these areas is permitted and butts should be disposed of properly.
- 🐾 No alcoholic beverages are allowed on the property unless under the direct supervision of an instructor and with prior approval by the Training Director.
- 🐾 Firearms and explosive devices are strictly prohibited anywhere on the property.
- 🐾 No dog shall ever be treated harshly or inhumanely. No hitting, yanking, scruffing, pinning, or other rough, aversive treatment is allowed. Membership revocation may occur.
- 🐾 The facility is under video surveillance. By signing this form you give permission to be videotaped.

Agility Field Rules

Help us keep the field clean and the grass healthy for everyone's enjoyment. The rules are set up with safety in mind.

- 🐾 Discourage your dog from eliminating on the agility field. Use the areas outside of the fence. If elimination occurs clean it up completely and immediately, and place solid waste in the designated container.
- 🐾 No glass containers are allowed anywhere in the agility area.
- 🐾 Do not hook the leash to the fence of dogs that are big or persistent pullers.
- 🐾 Keep the barking of your dogs to a minimum in consideration of the commercial and residential buildings nearby.
- 🐾 Try to avoid the inadvertent dropping of treats on the field. It is distracting to novice users. Please use a secure pouch.
- 🐾 All dogs must be actively supervised. Pay attention to your dog!
- 🐾 Dogs using the agility equipment should be wearing a flat buckle collar with no hanging tags to catch on any equipment.
- 🐾 No digging or play activities that rip up the turf.
- 🐾 Prevent your dog from urinating on the equipment. If it happens please clean it off immediately.
- 🐾 Share the time on the field with any other members who may show up: 10 minutes on; 10 minutes off.
- 🐾 Be considerate of others.
- 🐾 If you must move any equipment on a course that has been set up for a class, please replace it when finished.
- 🐾 Immediately report via email any equipment or facility issues.

Before Leaving Lucky Dog

- 🐾 Take any personal items.
- 🐾 Pick up trash and dog waste. Solid waste is placed in containers outside of the building.
- 🐾 Inside, consider sweeping up if you have left a mess in consideration for the next member using the space. Brooms are hanging inside each training room.
- 🐾 Make sure gates and/or doors are locked and closed securely.
- 🐾 Agility field users: Please put away the equipment (unless a course is set up for future use). The tunnels (turn ends down), tunnel holders, jump wings, and extra table legs, are put away in the designated area at the northwest corner of the building. We appreciate you putting away all jumps and jump bars. The equipment that can be left on the field includes tables and the contact equipment. Please do not leave jump bars on the ground for the maintenance crew to accidentally mow over them.
- 🐾 The pole light at the back of the field (west side) should be turned off before you leave. The switch for this light on the agility field is located near the equipment storage area on the northwest corner of the building.
- 🐾 Turn off the hose near the back door and outside by the patio area. Dump out the water in the trough if you have filled it and leave it turned upside down.
- 🐾 Inside, rally and obedience equipment should be put away. The lights on the south side (large training room) turn on and off automatically. However, if you are using the north side training room, please turn off all lights before leaving.
- 🐾 Please close the front umbrella if there are high winds.
- 🐾 Raise all thermostats to 79 degrees.

Lucky Dog Training Club members who fail to comply with any of the established rules and regulations will be subject to suspension or revocation of their privileges and membership without any refund of fees.
